If your family is facing conflict, school challenges, or a crisis at home, you're not alone. The Family Crisis Intervention Unit (FCIU) provides **free crisis support** for Monmouth County youth ages 10–17 and their families. We help calm difficult situations, prevent court involvement, and guide families toward a healthier, more stable future.

Our team works with you to address challenges like arguments between parents and children, missing school, running away from home, safety concerns, and other behavior or school-related problems. We focus on building stronger relationships, supporting school success, and connecting your family with resources that truly make a difference.

We meet families where they are - at home, in our office, or another safe location - and create a plan that works for your unique situation. We listen without judgment, focus on practical solutions, and help you take the next steps toward peace and stability.

Program Benefits:

- Immediate help Crisis response in person or by phone, with after-hours support
- Support that comes to you in-home or office visits based on your needs
- Hands-on assistance with case management and resource connections
- Focused in-home therapy (up to 16 weeks) when eligible through the Parent-Child Conflict Resolution Program (WRAP)
