The Adolescent Pregnancy Prevention Initiative (APPI) is a collaborative early intervention program that empowers students through education on healthy relationships, pregnancy prevention, and personal development. Through individual and group counseling, youth build confidence, strengthen communication, and gain the knowledge to make informed choices and achieve their goals.

Eligibility:

APPI services are available to all Keansburg High School students, regardless of grade level or background.

Program Benefits:

- Counseling focused on healthy relationships and HIV/STI prevention
- Psychoeducational groups on communication, self-esteem, goal-setting, and life skills
- Access to resources (e.g., condoms, pregnancy tests, etc.)
- Opportunities to participate in school-based events and activities
- Supportive, inclusive environment with referrals to community resources
